1 – A single student can use a stack of cards to sharpen his or her knowledge of important places in the Bible.

- 2 Play a "Bible Places" game. Shuffle the cards and stack them clue side up. Players take turns drawing the top card and reading the clues. The others take turns trying to guess the name of the place. Players collect the cards they correctly identify. If no one identifies the place, show everyone the answer on the back of the card and return it to the bottom of the pile. The player who collects the most cards wins.
- 3 Use both sets of cards. Place the clues from one set face up on a table. Place the name sides of the other set face up. Mix and match. Make this a group activity by having students help each other match the clues with the places. With information on both sides of the cards, the activity is selfcorrecting.
- 4 Randomly spread selected cards name side up on a table. Students work alone or in small groups to arrange the places in biblical order. With references as one of the clues, the activity is self-correcting.
