How Well Do You Know Genesis?

Print each question on a file card as shown.

What was Jacob's name
changed to when
he wrestled with an angel?

<u>Genesis 32:28</u>

Place the cards face down in a pile. The children take turns drawing the top card and reading the question that is on it. If they can answer the question correctly, they keep the card. If not, the card must be returned face down at the bottom of the pile. At the end of the game, the number of cards each player has collected is his or her score.

Variation. This game can also be played as a game of concentration. Spread out the cards, face down, on a table. The children take turns picking up a card and trying to answer the question that is on it. Again they keep the card if they answer the question correctly. Otherwise they must return the card, face down, to its original place on the table. Another child who knows the answer to the question can pick up the card when his or her turn comes around.

Suggestion: laminate the cards.
