
Ways to prepare a set of "Who Said It?" cards:

1 – Write the quotation on one side of a file card and the person/reference on the other side. Suggestion: laminate the cards.



2 – Download the ready-to-print pages below. Use 24 lb. or 28 lb., 8-1/2 x 11, paper and <u>print on both sides</u>, <u>starting with page 2</u> (flip pages on short edge). Cut out the cards. This makes two sets of "Who Said It?" cards. Suggestion: laminate the cards.



The cards can be used several ways:

- 1 A single student can use the cards to sharpen his or her knowledge of important Bible sayings and who said them.
- 2 Play a "Who Said It? Genesis" game. Shuffle both sets of cards and stack them quotation side up. Players take turns drawing the top card, reading the quotation aloud, and guessing who said it. If they guess correctly, they keep the card. If not, the other players guess. If no one guesses correctly, show everyone the answer on the back of the card and return it to the bottom of the pile. At the end, the player who collects the most cards wins. Make the game more challenging by guessing the Bible reference as well!
- 3 Use both sets of cards. Place the quotations from one set face up on a table. Place the person/reference sides of the other set face up. Mix and match. Make this a group activity by having the students help each other match the people with their sayings. With information on both sides of the cards, the activity is self-correcting.
- 4 Spread a few cards on a table, quotation side up. Give the students one or more questions to answer by studying the sayings. For example, (1) Who said it? (2) Why did they say it? (3) Where is the saying found? (4) What does the saying tell us about the person?
