## Finding Christ in the Psalms – Psalms 2-34 ESV

**Ps 2:1-2** Why do the nations \_\_\_\_\_\_ (20 down) and the peoples \_\_\_\_\_\_ (32 down) in vain? The kings of the earth \_\_\_\_\_\_ (31 across) themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the \_\_\_\_\_\_ (30 down) and against his \_\_\_\_\_\_ (10 down).
