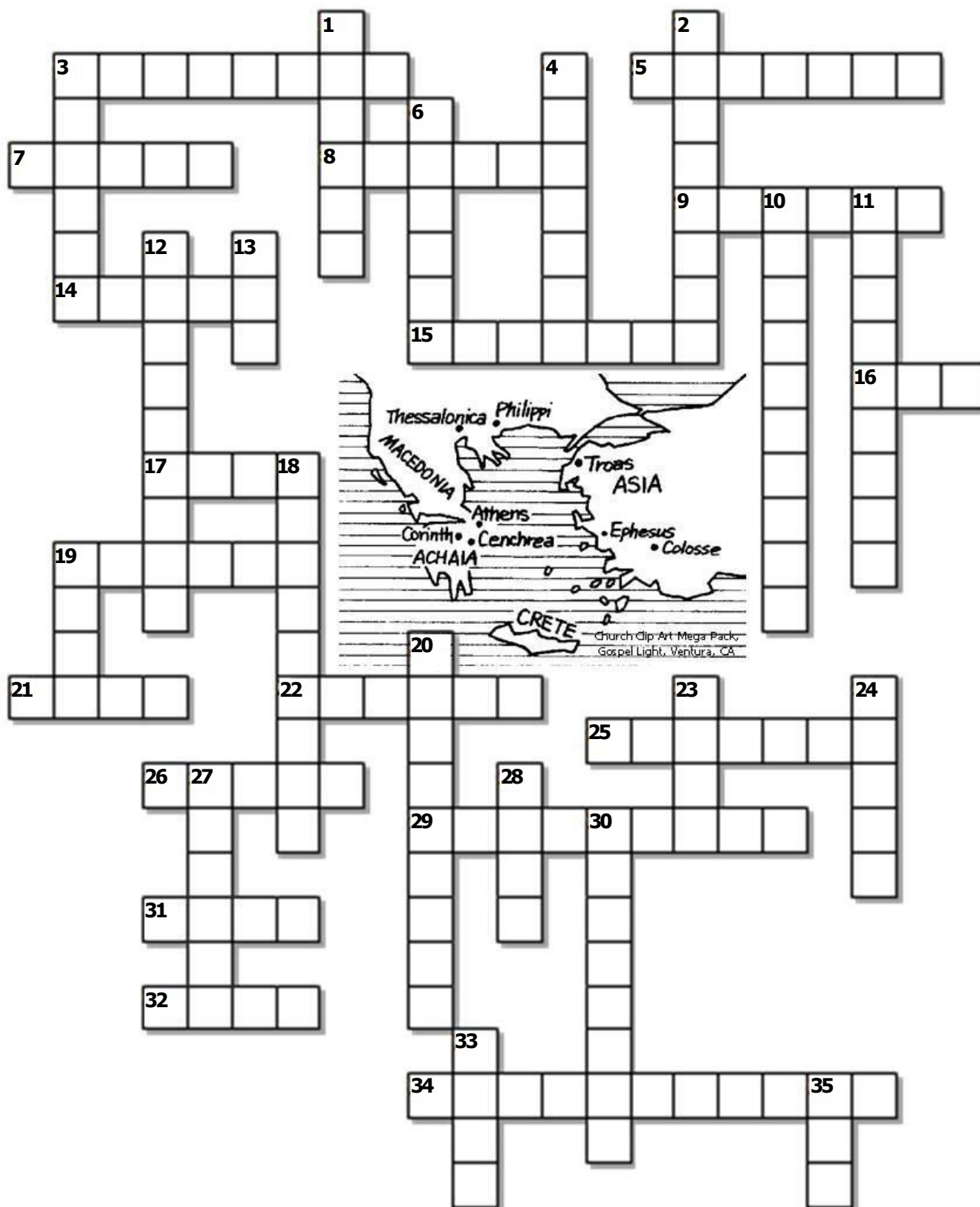


Acts 19 ~ Paul's Third Missionary Journey



Acts 19 ~ Paul's Third Missionary Journey ~ King James Version

Read Acts 19 in a King James Bible. Then follow the text below and try to do the crossword puzzle without looking back at the Bible.

Acts 19:1 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to **(15 Across)**: and finding certain disciples, ² He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. ³ And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. ⁴ Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of **(10 Down)**, saying unto the people, that they should **(4 Down)** on him which should come after him, that is, on **(9 Across)** Jesus. ⁵ When they heard *this*, they were **(3 Across)** in the name of the Lord Jesus. ⁶ And when Paul had laid *his* hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. ⁷ And all the men were about **(6 Down)**.

⁸ And he went into the **(11 Down)**, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the **(5 Across)** of God. ⁹ But when divers were hardened, and believed not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the **(22 Across)** of one Tyrannus. ¹⁰ And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in **(21 Across)** heard the word of the Lord **(24 Down)**, both **(23 Down)** and **(19 Across)**. ¹¹ And **(16 Across)** wrought special **(2 Down)** by the hands of Paul: ¹² So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

¹³ Then certain of the vagabond Jews, **(29 Across)**, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. ¹⁴ And there were seven sons of *one* Sceva, a Jew, *and* chief of the priests, which did so. ¹⁵ And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? ¹⁶ And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they **(17 Across)** out of that house naked and wounded. ¹⁷ And this was known to all the Jews and

Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was (12 Down).¹⁸ And many that believed came, and (20 Down), and shewed their deeds.¹⁹ Many of them also which used curious (32 Across) brought their books together, and (3 Down) them before all *men*: and they counted the price of them, and found *it* fifty thousand *pieces* of silver.²⁰ So mightily grew the (31 Across) of God and prevailed.

21 After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see (28 Down).²² So he sent into Macedonia two of them that ministered unto him, Timotheus and Erastus; but he himself stayed in Asia for a season.²³ And the same time there arose no small stir about that way.²⁴ For a certain *man* named Demetrius, a (34 Across), which made silver shrines for (14 Across), brought no small gain unto the craftsmen;²⁵ Whom he called together with the workmen of like occupation, and said, Sirs, ye know that by this craft we have our (1 Down).²⁶ Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be no (19 Down), which are made with hands:²⁷ So that not only this our craft is in danger to be set at nought; but also that the temple of the great goddess Diana should be despised, and her magnificence should be destroyed, whom all Asia and the world worshippeth.²⁸ And when they heard *these sayings*, they were full of (7 Across), and cried out, saying, Great *is* Diana of the Ephesians.²⁹ And the whole (33 Down) was filled with confusion: and having caught Gaius and Aristarchus, men of Macedonia, Paul's companions in travel, they rushed with one accord into the (25 Across).³⁰ And when Paul would have entered in unto the people, the disciples suffered him not.³¹ And certain of the chief of Asia, which were his friends, sent unto him, desiring *him* that he would not adventure himself into the theatre.³² Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: for the assembly was (30 Down); and the more part knew not wherefore they were come together.³³ And they drew Alexander out of the multitude, the Jews putting him forward. And Alexander beckoned with the hand, and would have made his defence unto the people.³⁴ But when they knew that he was a Jew, all with one voice about the space of (35 Down) hours cried out, Great *is* Diana of the Ephesians.³⁵ And when the town clerk had appeased the people, he said, *Ye* men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that

the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the *image* which fell down from Jupiter? ³⁶ Seeing then that these things cannot be spoken against, ye ought to be **(26 Across)**, and to do nothing rashly. ³⁷ For ye have brought hither these men, which are neither robbers of churches, nor yet blasphemers of your goddess. ³⁸ Wherefore if Demetrius, and the craftsmen which are with him, have a matter against any man, the **(13 Down)** is open, and there are deputies: let them implead one another. ³⁹ But if ye enquire anything concerning other matters, it shall be determined in a **(8 Across)** assembly. ⁴⁰ For we are in danger to be called in question for this day's **(27 Down)**, there being no cause whereby we may give an account of this concourse. ⁴¹ And when he had thus spoken, he **(18 Down)** the assembly.
