

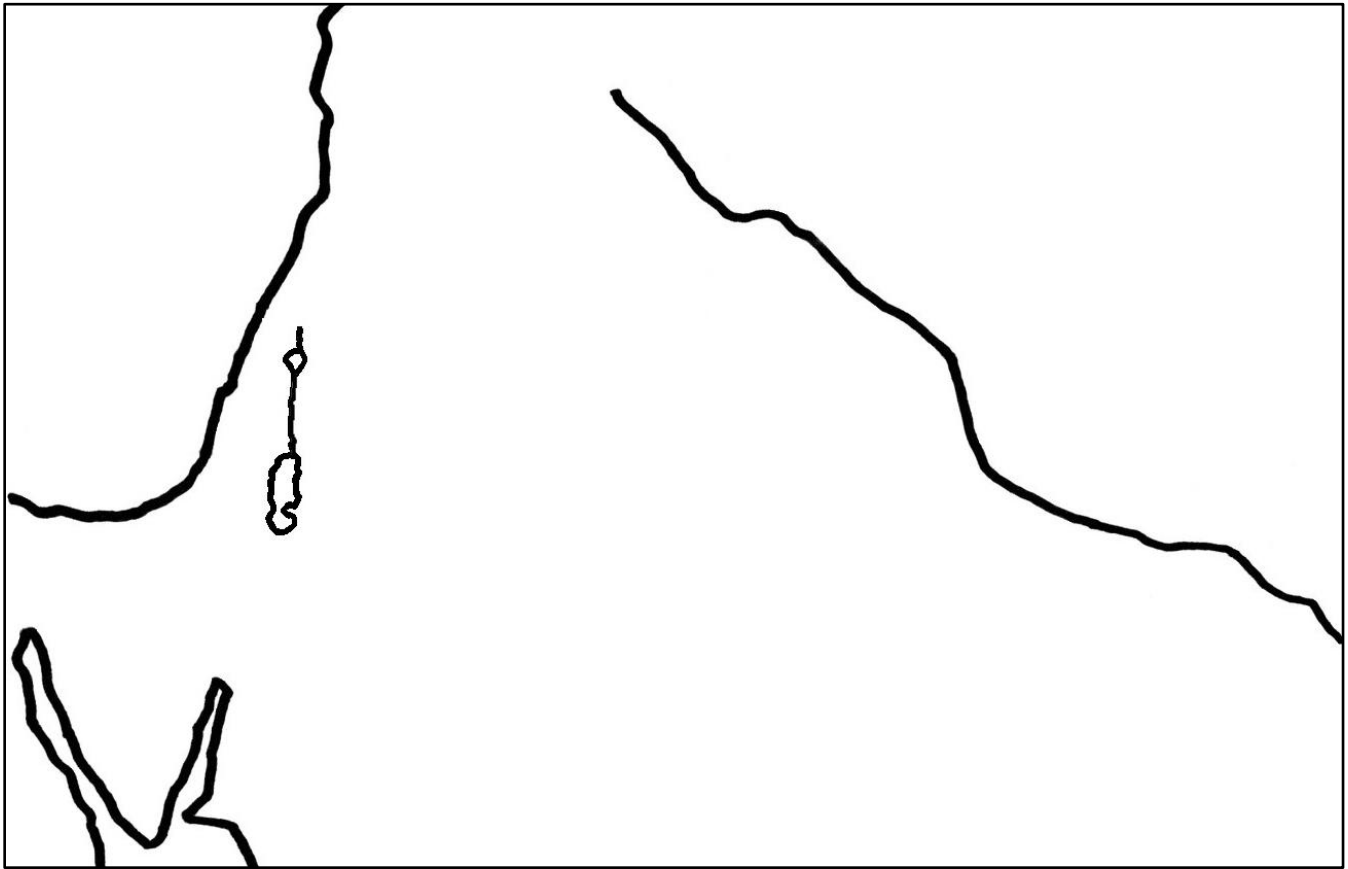
Bible Study Tools – Bible Maps
